3. Purpose of Personal Data Collection

Personal data is employed to deliver Helsinki EU Office newsletters. Subscriber can subscribe to Helsinki EU Office Newsletter, and the register contains subscriber's email addresses. The processing of personal data occurs on subscriber's explicitly given consent.

4. Personal data to be found from the register

5. The Source of Personal Data

The main source for personal data is the order form for the newsletter at the Helsinki EU Office web page. The collection of email addresses is also possible from other places if the person in question has given their explicit consent to have their email address added to the Helsinki EU Office newsletter mailing list.

6. Access to Personal Data

Only the employees of the Helsinki EU Office can access personal data in the register. Personal data is not released outside of the Helsinki EU Office. Helsinki EU Office newsletter service provider The Rocket Science Group (MailChimp) can handle information to improve and market their services. Mailchimp does not sell personal data forward to third parties.

7. Transferring and giving up personal data to third countries and international organizations

For newsletter communication, Helsinki EU Office uses Mailchimp email service located in the United States. This means personal information will be transferred outside of the European Union

to the United States. However, this information transfer is observed to follow the principles of general data protection regulation.

8. Storage Period for Personal Data

Data will be stored as long as the newsletter is published or until the subscriber will terminate their newsletter subscription.

9. The Rights of the Registered

The registered person can cancel their newsletter subscription at any time from the unsubscribe-link below the newsletter. Newsletter published via email can be unsubscribed by sending a message to the newsletter's email address.

The registered person has a right to following:

- to know what kind of information register contains about them
- request their personal information to be corrected
- get their personal information erased from the register
- limit the processing of their data
- move data from one system to another

The request should be sent to via email to toimisto@uudenmaanliitto.fi or via postal service to Uudenmaan liitto, Esterinportti 2 B, 00240 Helsinki, Finland. The message should come attached with "Request of information inspection in the Helsinki EU Office newsletter register". The right to request your newsletter information inspection is free of charge once per year. Furthermore, the registered person has a right to make a complaint to authorized representative of data protection.

10. Profiling

The register is not used for profiling or to other forms of automatic decision-making.
